Cuyamaca College Rising Scholars: Grant Goals 2020-2021 to 2023-2024

Report Prepared February 2025

Cuyamaca College's Rising Scholars program supports the success of justice-involved students. The program set annual goals to increase the number of justice-involved students enrolled, increase access to Counseling services, increase fall-to-spring persistence for first-time students, and increase certificate and degree completion relative to the 2020-2021 baseline academic year. The program exceeded these four goals as of 2023-2024 (year 3).

Goal 1: Increase Students Enrolled as of Census

In the Fall 2020 baseline semester, 19 Cuyamaca College Rising Scholars were enrolled as of census at the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (GCCCD). Compared to the baseline student headcount, there was a 47% decrease to 10 Rising Scholars in Fall 2021 (year 1), and a 5% decrease to 18 students in Fall 2022 (year 2). In Fall 2023 (year 3), 26 Rising Scholars were enrolled, reflecting a 37% increase from the baseline semester. This exceeds the program's goal of a 20% increase in Rising Scholars enrolled in the fall semester as of census by year 3.

Goal 2: Increase Access to Counseling

In the 2020-2021 baseline academic year, 21 of the 32 Rising Scholars (66%) received Counseling services. This Counseling access rate increased 22% in 2021-2022 (year 1), increased 47% in 2022-2023 (year 2), and increased 25% in 2023-2024 (year 3), in which 28 of the 34 Rising Scholars (82%) received Counseling services. This exceeds the program's goal of a 20% increase in access to Counseling by year 3.

Goal 3: Increase First-Time Student Persistence

The 2020-2021 Rising Scholars cohort included seven first-time students who started at GCCCD in the Summer or Fall 2020 semesters. Of these seven first-time students, one persisted to the Spring 2021 semester, resulting in a 14% persistence rate. This persistence rate increased 600% in 2021-2022 (year 1), with the one first-time student persisting to Spring 2022. Compared to the 2020-2021 baseline, the persistence rate increased 250% in 2022-2023 (year 2), and increased 444% in 2023-2024 (year 3). This exceeds the program's goal to increase first-time students' persistence rates 20% by year 3.

Goal 4: Increase Certificate and Degree Completion

Three of the 32 Rising Scholars students in the 2020-2021 cohort completed a GCCCD certificate or degree by the end of the 2023-2024 academic year, representing a 9% completion rate. This completion rate increased 113% in 2021-2022 (year 1), increased 105% in 2022-2023 (year 2), and increased 25% in 2023-2024 (year 3). This exceeds the program's goal to increase certificate and degree completion rates 20% by year 3.
